

SUMMER READING CHALLENGE - 2026

Richland Library (LRC) is hosting a summer reading challenge this summer. We have created a game card with 9 different reading prompts.

Don't think you have time? Prompts are worded so you can adjust your choice of reading material to what you have time to read.

HINT: A reading assignment can work, if it is a complete piece. For example: an article or book. However, a book chapter or a reading selection would not be a complete piece.

The titles of anything you read for this game will only be seen by the library staff. As always, we will not share your information.

There will be 3 ways to get prizes.

Progress Prizes: Snacks

- Finish 3 prompts in a row (any direction) and/or finish the 4 corners

Completion Prize: Gift bag of goodies and a gift card to RCC Cafe/Coffee Shop

- Finish all 9 challenges.

Grand Prize: Tote bag with goodies and a gift card to Kroger or Walmart.

- Drawing will be held on AUG. 28, 2026, at 2pm.

How to Get a Game Card:

- Pick one up at the library 8am to 6pm.
- Email AskALibrarian@richland.edu and ask for one to be emailed to you.

How to Complete the 9 Reading Prompts:

- Read in any order you would like to read them.
- Read whatever you would like, if it fulfills the parameters of the prompt.
- You may only use a title/author once on your game card.
- To get a prize your game card must have your contact info and the title & author for each prompt on the backside.
- **HINT-** There are suggestions & helpful links posted on [Library Resources](#) on myRichland.edu
 - They are mostly books, however, as mentioned you are not limited to books.

How to Get Prizes:

- To get prizes & into the drawing you must complete the back of the game card with title & author for each prompt that you read and your name & contact information.
 - Completed game cards must be in by Aug. 28, 2026 @ 1:45pm to be included in drawing.
 - Completed game cards turned after the drawing can still collect the completion prize.
- Bring your game card with the list of the prompts & title/author you've read to the library.
- Email your game card with the list of the prompts & title/author you've read to AskALibrarian@richland.edu.
